LOCATION:	Cowarts is located in Houston County, Alabama and is a part of the Dothan, Alabama metropolitan area.
POPULATION:	In 2012 the population was 1,929, 26% urban and 74% rural and 48.6% male and 51.4% female.
MEDIAN INCOME:	In 2011 the estimated medium household income was \$36,678 compared to \$41,415 for the state of Alabama.
